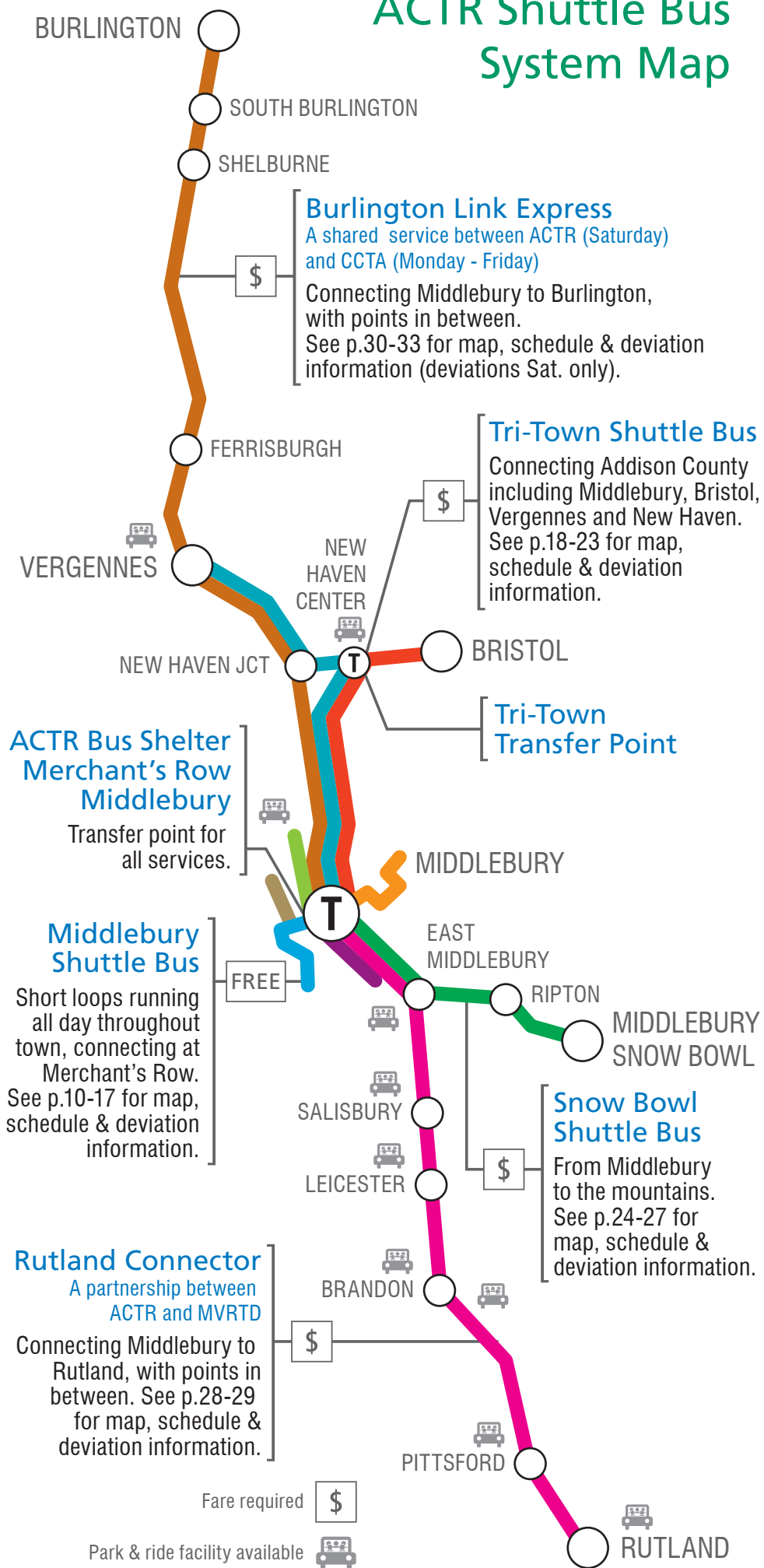

Welcome Aboard!

It's been 6 months since we launched our 40% Shuttle Bus System Expansion and ridership has already increased by 25%! This is remarkable, since our pilot grant allows us three years to hit our performance benchmarks. We are pleased to receive this ringing endorsement of our efforts to provide you an improved system!



PLEASE NOTE: There are several slight, but important, changes in the schedules for the Middlebury "Route 7 South" loop (pages 16-17), the Tri-Town Bristol route (pages 20-21) and – especially – the Tri-Town Vergennes route (pages 22-23). These were made to improve our system's efficiency, effectiveness and reliability.

Highlights include:

- Time points for key stops on the "Route 7 South" loop are slightly altered;
- Vergennes Post Office is re-instated as the primary in-city stop;
- Vergennes Shaw's Plaza now receives greater service frequency;
- Ferrisburgh Park & Ride is no longer served (due to very low ridership).

In addition, we have clarified ACTR's fare-free zones (page 5) and how riders should get to and from Exchange Street in Middlebury (page 5).

Thank you for your patience and your loyalty – we remain dedicated to providing affordable, safe and reliable public transportation.

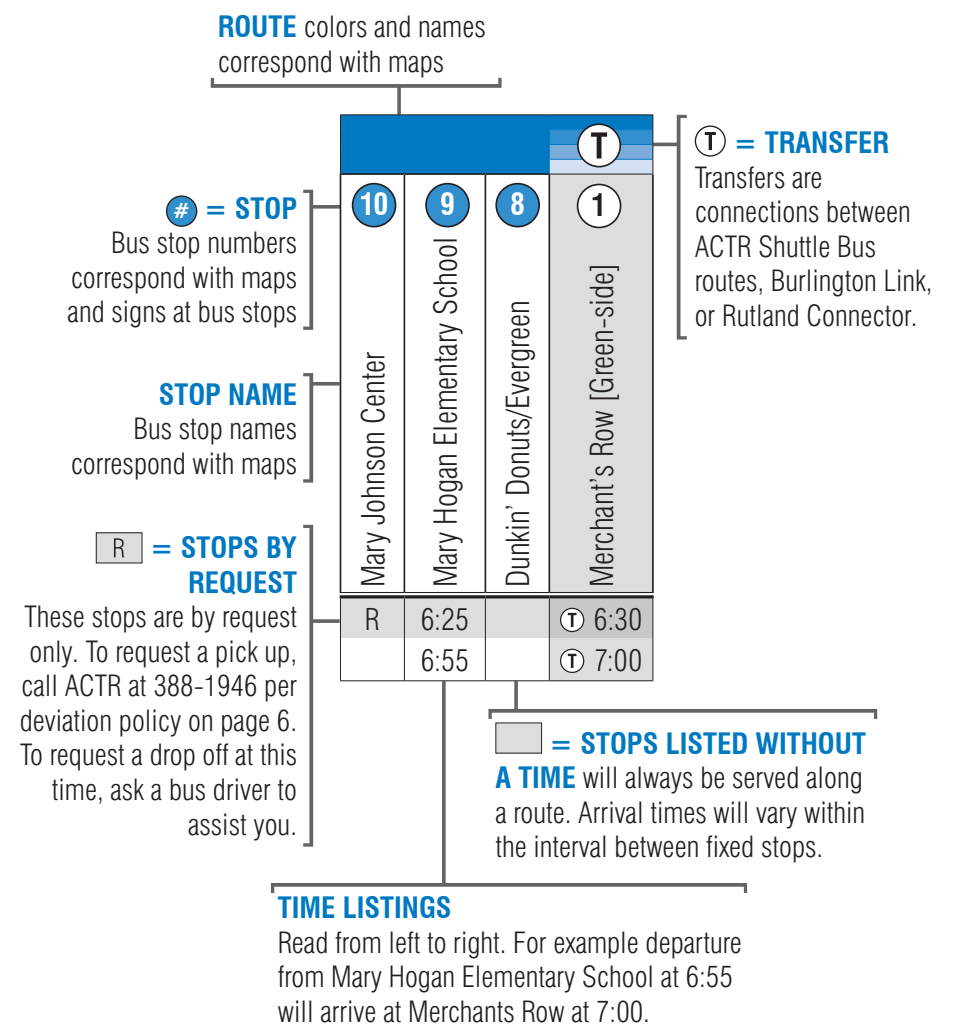

Did you know?

- All ACTR bus routes are open to the general public and timed to provide seamless transfers at all transfer points, including New Haven Town Center and the ACTR bus shelter.
- The MSB now has 5 loops and continually circulates throughout Middlebury Monday - Saturday 52 weeks a year and is FARE FREE!

About ACTR

ACTR is a 501(c)(3) non-profit agency. Most of ACTR's state and federal grants cover 80% of the cost of services. ACTR relies upon the generous support from individuals, businesses, towns and philanthropic organizations to raise the remaining 20% local match.

ACTR's Mission & Safety Pledge

ACTR's mission is to enhance the economic, social and environmental health of the region by providing public transportation services that are safe, reliable, accessible and affordable for everyone.

ACTR pledges to ensure the safety of its passengers, employees, volunteers and the community through the following commitments:

- All staff and volunteers have background checks completed prior to providing any service;
- All staff including drivers, senior management and dispatchers participate in random drug and alcohol-testing program;
- All vehicles owned and operated by ACTR are inspected prior to every shift for safety and cleanliness, and have preventative maintenance performed on a regular basis;
- All vehicles owned by volunteer drivers have up-to-date safety inspections and are expected to be in a clean and comfortable condition.

ACTR pledges to constantly renew its efforts towards safety and to continuously seek new programs and opportunities to increase system safety.

ACTR Fare Information

General Fare Policies

- Passengers under age 6 ride free with a fare-paying passenger.
- Passengers ages 6 to 17, age 60+ or with an ADA disability ride for ½ price (one-way and passes).
- Passengers can self-certify their age or disability.
- No transfer passes; fare paid for each route.
- Fares owed regardless of distance traveled.
- Only exact change or passes accepted

Middlebury Shuttle Bus (MSB) is fare-free but donations are always welcome!

ACTR Fare Information (cont.)

In-County Routes

On the in-county routes, ACTR collects fares on the Tri-Town Bristol and Tri-Town Vergennes Shuttles (TTSB) and the Snow Bowl Shuttle (SBSB) routes. The fare structure is as follows:

Tri-Town Bristol Shuttle & Tri-Town Vergennes Shuttle	Snow Bowl Shuttle
\$1 per one-way trip	\$1 per one-way trip
\$9 for 10-ride pass	\$9 for 10-ride pass
\$30 for monthly pass	Monthly passes (only available Jan. - Feb.)

Fare Exceptions: Tri-Town Shuttle Bus

- No fare is required to transfer between the Tri-Town Bristol and Tri-Town Vergennes shuttle buses at New Haven Center.
- No fare is required when traveling to/from locations on Exchange Street in Middlebury (this is considered part of the Middlebury "fare-free zone"). Please inform your driver of your destination when traveling to Exchange Street.

Fare Exceptions: Snow Bowl Shuttle Bus

- No fare is required when traveling to/from locations along Route 7 South in Middlebury (this is considered part of the Middlebury "fare-free zone"). Please inform your driver of your destination when traveling to Route 7 South.

Out-of-County Routes

The fare on **The Rutland Connector** is \$2 per one-way trip, \$18.00 for 10-ride pass and \$60 for monthly pass.

The fare on the **Burlington LINK** is \$4 per one-way trip, \$40 for a 10-ride pass and \$125 for a 31-day pass. The 10-ride and monthly passes are only available through CCTA for use on the Monday through Friday Burlington LINK operated by CCTA. ACTR operates the Saturday service only, which is \$4 per one-way trip.

ACTR Passes


ACTR passes can be purchased with exact change from bus drivers and at the ACTR offices, 282 Boardman Street, Middlebury, from 7 am to 5 pm Monday through Friday. For more information call the ACTR offices 802 388-1946 or visit the website, www.actr-vt.org

Using the Bus System is Easy!

ACTR intends to provide public transportation that is as user friendly as possible. Listed on the next few pages is detailed information about how the shuttle buses work.

Bus Stops: Buses will pick-up or drop-off passengers at all locations with ACTR bus stop signs. All bus stop signs are numbered to match up with the new map and schedule information in order to improve riders understanding of the system. Passengers may also request other pick-ups or drop-offs, or may wave the bus down at any safe location along the route.

Deviations: ACTR buses will deviate up to a ½ mile (¼ mile for Rutland Connector and Saturday LINK) from the published routes to pick-up or drop-off passengers. To request a deviation, call ACTR a day in advance at 802-388-1946 or ask a bus driver to assist you. If your deviation request cannot be accommodated at the desired schedule time then, per federal law, ACTR will provide the service up to 1 hour before or after the requested time.

 **Wheelchair Lifts:** All vehicles are equipped with wheelchair lifts. If you require the use of a wheelchair lift, our trained drivers will assist you in getting on and off the bus.

Put Your Bike on the Bus: All ACTR buses are equipped with bike racks. Each rack can accommodate two bicycles. Bicycles may also be brought in the bus if necessary and space is available. Riders are responsible for loading and unloading their own bicycles.

Transfers: Please confirm with the driver as you are boarding if you will need to transfer to another bus. There are no transfer passes; fare paid for each route regardless of distance traveled.

Skateboard, Skis & Snowboards: All of these are welcome on the bus provided they are kept out of the aisles.

Service Animals and Pets: Service animals, animals contained in pet carriers or with a muzzle and leash are allowed on ACTR buses. Other bus systems may not allow non-service animals on-board. Please check with CCTA at 802-864-0211 or MVRTD at 802-773-3244 if you plan to connect with another system.

Lost & Found: ACTR cannot be responsible for items left on the bus. However, items found on the bus may be picked up at the ACTR

offices at 282 Boardman Street between 7 am and 5 pm Monday - Friday. Call 802-388-1946 to be sure your item(s) have been found. Items are kept for 30 days.

Special Assistance: To ensure the best possible service, all riders needing special assistance are encouraged to call the office ahead of time.

Child Seats: All ACTR buses have built-in child seats. Ask the driver for assistance if you need to use a child seat. If you bring your own, please be sure it is secured correctly.

Safe Service Policy: Please note service may be modified at times on a case-by-case basis due to safety conditions.

Emergency Information: In case of bad weather or emergency, please call the ACTR office at 802-388-1946 or listen to WVTK 92.1 FM radio for information on the ACTR bus system or www.actr-vt.org.

ACTR's Code of Conduct

To ensure everyone has a safe and comfortable journey on ACTR buses, the following must be observed while riding with ACTR:

- 1 Please stay seated, keep aisle clear and do not disturb other passengers.
- 2 Seats in front of the bus are reserved for elders, passengers with disabilities and those needing child seats.
- 3 Use headphones when listening to personal music devices.
- 4 Keep all food and beverages in closed containers.
- 5 Use the trash bin in the front of the bus.
- 6 For safety and sanitary reasons, all passengers are required to wear shoes and shirts, and limit odors that disturb other passengers.
- 7 Offensive language including, but not limited to, racial slurs or derogatory remarks based on race, gender or sexual orientation is prohibited on ACTR vehicles.
- 8 The ACTR bus driver has the right to refuse service to those who do not comply with the ACTR Code of Conduct.

Title VI of the Civil Rights Act

ACTR operates its programs and service without regard to race, color and national origin as stipulated in the Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964. If you feel you have been discriminated against based on your race, color or national origin, you may file a complaint with the Vermont Agency of Transportation's Title VI Coordinator at 802 828-5561. If you would like more information about your Title VI rights, please visit www.aot.state.vt.us/CivilRights/default.htm or call 802 828-5561.

Vermont State Public Accommodation Law

9 V.S.A. § 4502 (a) Public accommodations states an owner or operator of a place of public accommodation or an agent or employee of such owner or operator shall not, because of the race, creed, color, national origin, marital status, sex, sexual orientation, or gender identity of any person, refuse, withhold from, or deny to that person any of the accommodations, advantages, facilities, and privileges of the place of public accommodation.

If you feel you have been discriminated against, you may file a complaint with Vermont Human Rights Commission by calling 1-800-416-2010 or by e-mail at human.rights@state.vt.us.

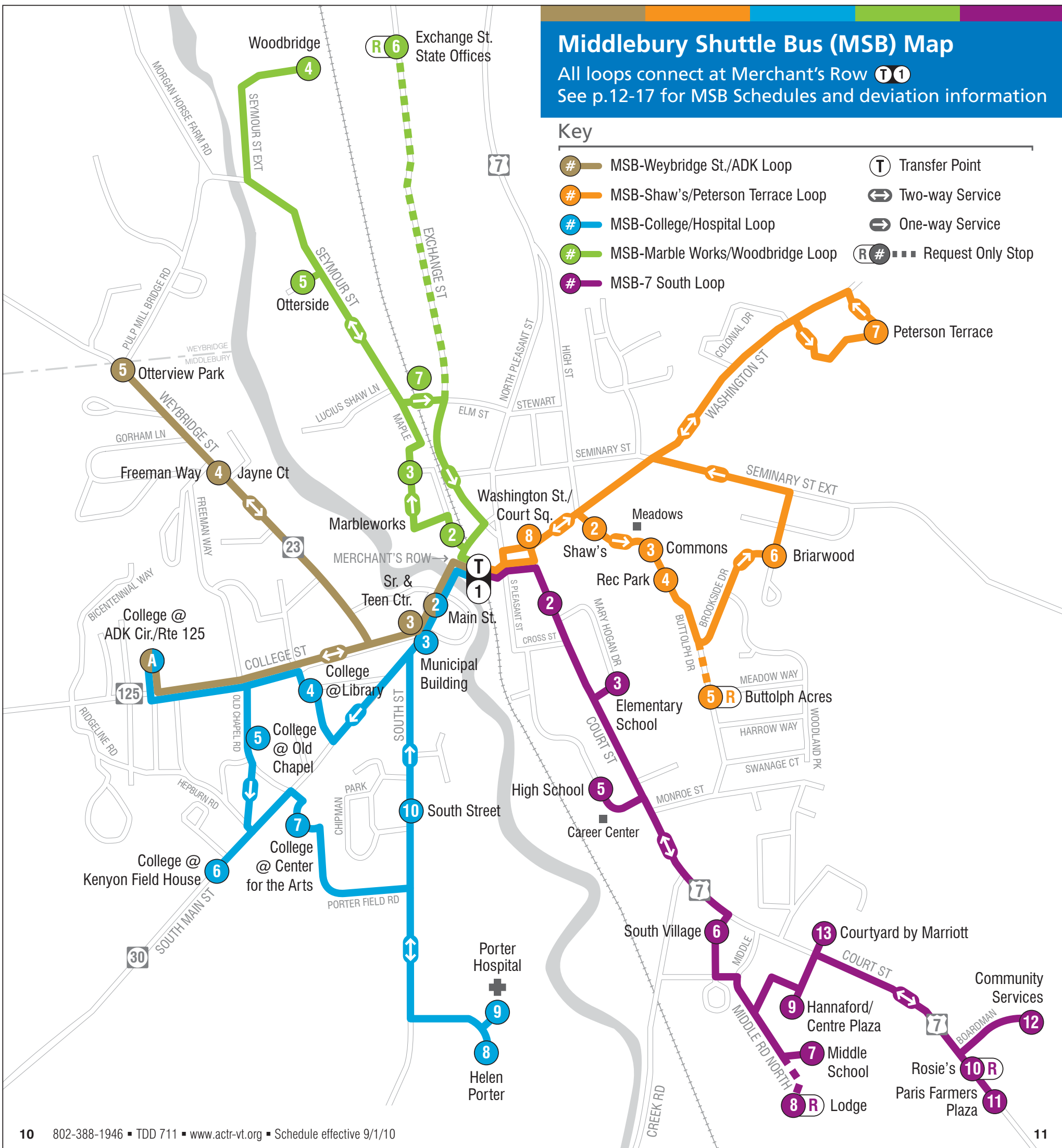

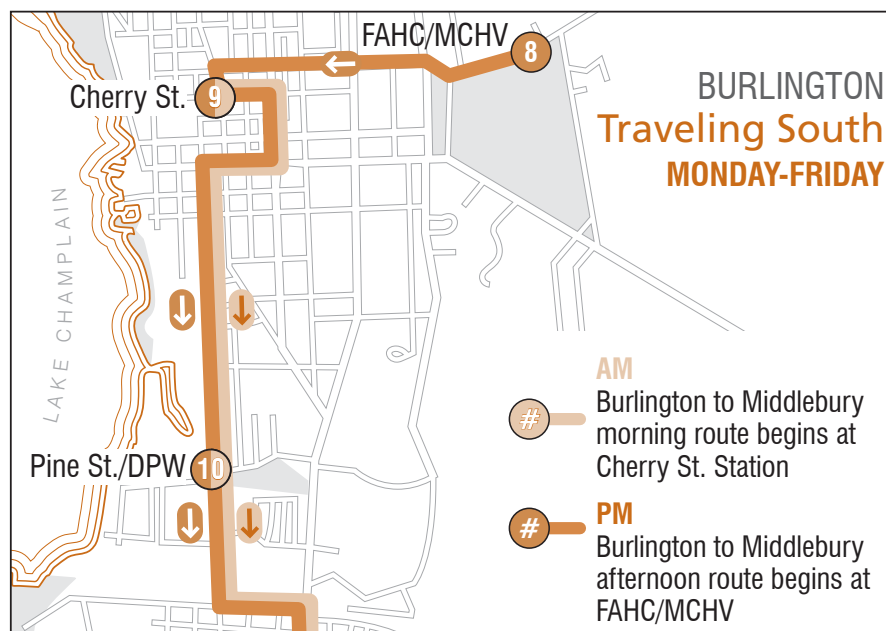
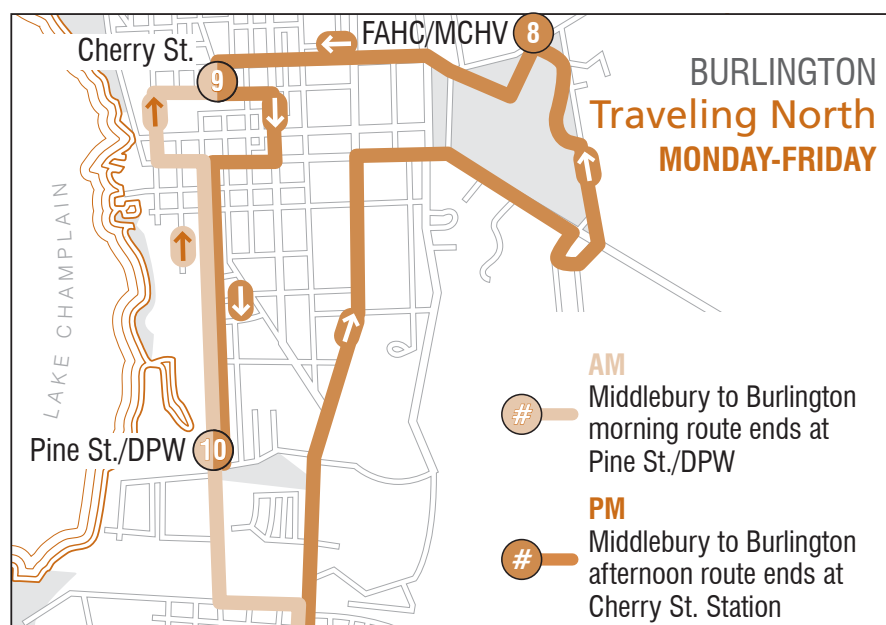


Burlington Link Express (LINK) Map



Beyond the Bus . . .

ACTR's Dial-A-Ride System

In addition to its Shuttle Bus System, ACTR also operates a Dial-A-Ride System. This system enhances ACTR's ability to provide comprehensive transportation alternatives for all Addison County residents. The Dial-A-Ride System includes programs that focus on specialized populations including elders, persons with disabilities, low-income families and individuals, as well as the visually impaired. If you are eligible for Medicaid, Reach Up, are aged 60+ or have a disability, you may be eligible for FREE transportation. More than 35 volunteer drivers work with ACTR to provide these rides.

These services include transporting elders to meal-sites in Bristol, Bridport, Middlebury and Vergennes, delivering Meals-on-Wheels and transporting county residents to medical, social or employment-related appointments and services or activities.
